- Falcons fly 25 to 34 m.p.h.
- Falcons have a dark streak below their eyes.
- They weigh 18 to 56 ounces.



Habitat

- Falcons live on every continent except Antarctica.
- Falcons like a cliff with dirt.



Food

- Sometimes falcons catch more food than they can eat.
- They attack much bigger animals than itself.
- They attach hawks, owls, ravens, vultures, cranes and geese.
- They hunt more than 2,000 different birds!



Life Cycle

- When the chick moves out the mom still feeds them for 2 months.
- The male must be hunting most of the time.



Fun Fact

- Peregrine falcons are the fastest flying bird on earth!
- Some falcons stay with the same parent for many years. Some choose a new parent every year.
- A lot of animals hunt falcon chicks.
